

## NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION - Bureau of Mining Regulation and Reclamation

The Administrator of the Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) gives notice that an application for a renewal/major modification of a Water Pollution Control Permit for the **Marigold Project**, a mining and beneficiation facility, has been properly filed with NDEP in Carson City. The Applicant for a renewal/modification of Water Pollution Control Permit **NEV0088040** (Permit) is:

Marigold Mining Company, Inc. P.O. Box 160 Valmy, NV 89438

The facility is located on public and private land in Humboldt County, within Sections 1,2, and 12, T32N, R42E; Sections 1, 11-13, 23-25, 35 and 36, T33N, R42E; Section 36 T34N, R42E; Sections 4-6 T32N, R43E; Sections 4-10, 16-21, and 28-33 T34N, R43E; and Sections 19, 20, 28, and 30-33, T34N, R43E, MDB&M, approximately 13 miles southwest of the town of Battle Mountain.

The Project consists of a discharge to groundwater from the dewatering of a mine, pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 445A.232.2.

The Administrator is constrained to either issue the Permit or deny the application. The Administrator has made the tentative decision to issue the new Permit.

Persons wishing to comment on the proposed Permit, recommend terms and conditions for consideration of incorporation into the Permit, or request a public hearing pursuant to NAC 445A.238, must submit their written comments, objections, or requests by hand delivery, U.S. Postal Service, facsimile, or e-mail transmittal, no later than 5:00 PM on the 30<sup>th</sup> day following the date of publication of this notice (submittal end date 5 February 2024) to:

All comments, objections, or requests received during the public notice period will be considered in the final determination regarding the Permit. If NDEP determines that written comments or requests indicate a significant degree of public interest in this matter, the Administrator shall schedule a public hearing in accordance with the requirements of NAC 445A.405.
