



NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes and/or the Clean Water Act, where applicable. The Administrator has received an application for a Groundwater Discharge, permit number NS0092036 from the following applicant:

Permit NS0092036, THATCHER COMPANY OF NEVADA:

The Permittee, Thatcher Company, has applied for the renewal of groundwater discharge permit NS0092036 for Thatcher Company of Nevada, formerly known as Sierra Chemical Company, located at 2302 Larkin Circle in Sparks, Nevada.

Thatcher Company of Nevada operates as a chemical distribution and manufacturing facility. Bulk chemicals arrive via rail-car and truck and are repackaged into smaller packages for resale. Wastewater is generated during the cleanout of the rail-car unloading areas and the rinsing of shipping containers. Wastewater is collected in containment sumps prior to being pumped into empty 350-gallon shipping containers (poly-totes) and then analyzed for pH. The wastewater is then neutralized by blending high pH wastewater with low pH wastewater. After the wastewater has been neutralized it is transferred to a 4,500-gallon water truck and used for dust control at the Kean Canyon site located one mile north of US I-80, approximately 3.5 miles east-northeast of the Thatcher Company of Nevada.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes, as amended, and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to issue Permit NS0092036 to discharge for a five (5) year period, subject to certain effluent limitations.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance should submit their comments or request, in writing, hand delivered or postmarked no later than 5:00 P.M. on 05/23/2025, either in person or by mail to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day period will be considered in the formulation of final determination(s) regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.

A public hearing on the proposed determination can be requested by the applicant, any affected State, any affected interstate agency, the Regional Administrator of EPA Region IX or any interested

agency, person or group of persons. The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. Any public hearing determined by the Administrator to be held must be conducted in the geographical area of the proposed discharge or any other area the Administrator determined to be appropriate. All public hearings must be conducted in accordance with NAC 445A.238.
