NOTICE OF DECISION – Bureau of Water Pollution Control

Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Permit Permit Number NVS040000

The Administrator of the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (the Division) has decided to issue the renewed National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit #NVS040000 to regulate discharge of stormwater associated with Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (“MS4”) to Waters of the United States in Nevada. This permit maintains compliance with the provisions of the Federal Clean Water Act as amended (33 U.S.C. 1251 et seq: the "Act") and Chapter 445A of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS). The Permittees shall comply with all provisions outlined in the permit and contained within an approved Stormwater Management Program (SWMP). Under this revision, the Division chose the comprehensive permitting approach. As a result, the permit includes “clear, specific, and measurable” requirements for all small MS4s and the function of the Notice of Intent (NOI) is only to establish certain minimum facts about the Permittee. The permit requires implementation of specific best management practices (BMPs), including development and implementation of a comprehensive stormwater management program (SWMP) to meet the MS4 permit standard and pollutant reduction requirements. Eligible dischargers shall submit a NOI, filing fee, and submit a comprehensive SWMP to the Division for review in accordance with the permit requirements.

The Permit will become effective **August 3, 2026**. The final determination of the Administrator may be appealed to the State Environmental Commission pursuant to NRS 445A.605. All requests for appeals must be filed by 5:00 PM, **August 13, 2026**, on SEC Form 3, with the State Environmental Commission, 901 South Stewart Street, Suite 4001, Carson City, Nevada 89701-5249.
