



NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes and/or the Clean Water Act, where applicable. The Administrator has received an application for a Groundwater Discharge, permit number NS0092030 from the following applicant:

Permit NS0092030, NORTHERN NEVADA CORRECTIONAL CENTER:

The Permittee, State of Nevada's Northern Nevada Correctional Center, has applied for the renewal of Permit NS0092030 for the Prison Farm/Dairy (PF/D), located at 1721 Snyder Avenue, in Carson City, Nevada. The PF/D utilizes reclaimed water supplied by the Carson City Water Resource Recovery Facility (CCWRRF, NS0090008). The reclaimed water meets Category B bacteriological quality, per Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 445A.276, but is not denitrified. The PF/D is an approximately 496-acre agricultural operation that surrounds the Northern Nevada Correctional Center in southeast Carson City. The PF/D has 28 cultivated fields, spanning approximately 496 acres, that support several different types of crops with alfalfa, mixed pasture (tall fescue, orchard grass, garrison creeping foxtail, and alfalfa), and grains being the most common. Annual water usage for the PF/D ranges from 1,250 to 1,400 acre-feet, or approximately 407 to 456 million gallons, with the total annual maximum flow being up to 538 million gallons, based on irrigation demand. The Permittee has a Reclaimed Water Management Plan (RWMP) (formerly known as an Effluent Management Plan) on file with the BWPC. No degradation of the groundwater of the State is anticipated based on continued adherence to conditions specified in this permit and the approved Reclaimed Water Management Plan (RWMP) required by the Bureau of Water Pollution Control as a condition of this permit. The Permittee also operates a wild horse holding facility, which is permitted under concentrated animal feeding operation (CAFO) permit NV0023574.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes, as amended, and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to issue Permit NS0092030 to discharge for a five (5) year period, subject to certain effluent limitations.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance should submit their comments or request, in writing, hand delivered or postmarked no later than 5:00 P.M. on 03/22/2025, either in person or by mail to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day period will be considered in the formulation of final determination(s) regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations.

Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.

A public hearing on the proposed determination can be requested by the applicant, any affected State, any affected interstate agency, the Regional Administrator of EPA Region IX or any interested agency, person or group of persons. The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. Any public hearing determined by the Administrator to be held must be conducted in the geographical area of the proposed discharge or any other area the Administrator determined to be appropriate. All public hearings must be conducted in accordance with NAC 445A.238.
