



NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes and/or the Clean Water Act, where applicable. The Administrator has received an application for a Groundwater Discharge, permit number NS0094015 from the following applicant:

Permit NS0094015, SILVER OAK GOLF COURSE:

The Permittee, Silver Oak Development LP., has applied for the renewal of groundwater discharge permit NS0094015 for the Silver Oak Golf Course located at 1251 Country Club Drive in Carson City, Nevada. The Permittee proposes to continue the use of secondary treated, denitrified, and disinfected reclaimed water (Category B per NAC 445A.276) from the Carson City Water Resource Recovery Facility (CCWRRF, Permit NS0090008) for irrigation of the golf course. Silver Oak Golf Course is a 160-acre, 18-hole course consisting of bent, rye, and blue grasses. Of the total acreage, approximately 151 acres are comprised of irrigated turf, landscape areas, and ponds supplied with reclaimed water. The facility includes seven (7) ponds, all of which receive reclaimed water and are lined with a 30-mil ultraviolet inhibited PVC liner. The ponds have been constructed to withstand a 100-year storm event while maintaining a minimum of two (2) feet of freeboard. Reclaimed water is conveyed from the CCWRRF to the golf course via a transmission pipeline that supplies the primary storage pond. Smaller ponds are supplied through 4-inch lateral lines originating from the primary pond.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes, as amended, and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to issue Permit NS0094015 to discharge for a five (5) year period, subject to certain effluent limitations.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance should submit their comments or request, in writing, hand delivered or postmarked no later than 5:00 P.M. on 04/24/2026, either in person or by mail to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day period will be considered in the formulation of final determination(s) regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.

A public hearing on the proposed determination can be requested by the applicant, any affected State, any affected interstate agency, the Regional Administrator of EPA Region IX or any interested

agency, person or group of persons. The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. Any public hearing determined by the Administrator to be held must be conducted in the geographical area of the proposed discharge or any other area the Administrator determined to be appropriate. All public hearings must be conducted in accordance with NAC 445A.238.
