



NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes and/or the Clean Water Act, where applicable. The Administrator has received an application for a Groundwater Discharge, permit number NS2004518 from the following applicant:

Permit NS2004518, LAKEVIEW EXECUTIVE GOLF COURSE:

The Permittee, Town of Pahrump, has applied for the renewal of Permit NS2004518 for the Lakeview Executive Golf Course (LEGC), located at 1471 Mt. Charleston Drive, in Pahrump, within Nye County, Nevada. The Permittee proposes to continue to use reclaimed water to irrigate golf course landscaping and fill associated pond areas falling within the course's boundary. The LEGC is composed of a clubhouse, pro shop, and 18-hole course, with common areas encompassing approximately 58 acres total. The golf course is spray irrigated with reclaimed water supplied by the Great Basin Water Company's UICN Wastewater Treatment Plant #3 (WWTP #3) (permit NS0089063). The Category B reclaimed water per NAC 445A.276, is applied in accordance with the facility's approved Reclaimed Water Management Plan (formerly known as an Effluent Management Plan) and according to the terms and conditions of the permit.

Major Modification (September 05, 2025)

A major modification was performed to revise the monitoring requirements under the permit, Outfall EFF (Total Effluent), for the General Fecal Coliform and Total Nitrogen parameters. The two parameters were changed from a "Weekly" measurement frequency to a "Monthly" measurement frequency. This modification was being done to allow the golf course's requirements to match the measurement frequency of its reuse water supplier being UICN WWTP #3 (under permit NS0089063).

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes, as amended, and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to issue Permit NS2004518 to discharge for a five (5) year period, subject to certain effluent limitations.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance should submit their comments or request, in writing, hand delivered or postmarked no later than 5:00 P.M. on 10/20/2025, either in person or by mail to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day period will be considered in the formulation of final determination(s) regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the

tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.

A public hearing on the proposed determination can be requested by the applicant, any affected State, any affected interstate agency, the Regional Administrator of EPA Region IX or any interested agency, person or group of persons. The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. Any public hearing determined by the Administrator to be held must be conducted in the geographical area of the proposed discharge or any other area the Administrator determined to be appropriate. All public hearings must be conducted in accordance with NAC 445A.238.
