The purpose of this project is to construct a culvert within Governor's Channel associated with the Blackstone Ranch Project in Carson City, Nevada. The project consists of the construction and installation of a roadway, a reinforced concrete MEGA box culvert, upstream and downstream headwalls, upstream and downstream riprap, and utilities across the channel. The proposed MEGA box culvert consists of a total of three reinforced box culverts that are 120 feet long, 75 feet wide, and 6 feet tall. Approximately 1,086.50 square feet of rip rap will be placed upstream and approximately 808.888 square feet of rip rap will be placed downstream of the proposed box culvert. In addition to the construction of the roadway extension and box culvert across Governor's Channel, a series of four culverts for stormwater purposes and a roadway with a meandering trail will be constructed from E. 5th Street to Governor's Channel. The project proponent has requested certification for the use of Nationwide Permit 14 (Linear Transportation Projects) administered by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

A 401 certification (or a waiver of certification) is required for any federal license or permit that authorizes activities that may result in any discharge into waters of the United States. Nevada Division of Environmental Protection is in receipt of a complete request for certification in compliance with Clean Water Act Section 401 Certification regulations which the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency promulgated in 2023, codified as 40 CFR 121.

The Administrator is evaluating whether the proposed activity will comply with applicable water quality requirements. Certification actions are valid for the duration of the federal license or permit (typically five years). Any conditions contained within the certification action become a condition of the federal license or permit.

Persons wishing to comment on the application for consideration by the Administrator in making a determination regarding the certification action should submit their comments or request a hearing in writing, emailed no later than 5:00 P.M. on 9/15/2025:

The request for a hearing must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All water quality-related comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day period will be considered in the formulation of final certification action regarding the application. If written

comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.
