### NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Administrator, Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (Division), Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes and/or the Clean Water Act, where applicable.

The Administrator proposes to re-issue the Statewide General Permit, NVS040000, to regulate stormwater discharges associated with Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems ("MS4") to Waters of the United States. This permit maintains compliance with the provisions of the U.S. Clean Water Act as amended (33 U.S.C. 1251 et seq: the "Act") and Chapter 445A of the Nevada Revised Statutes. The Permittees shall comply with all provisions outlined in the permit and contained within an approved Stormwater Management Program (SWMP). Under this revision, the Division chose the comprehensive permitting approach. As a result, the permit includes "clear, specific, and measurable" requirements for all small MS4s and the function of the Notice of Intent is only to establish certain minimum facts about the Permittee. The permit requires implementation of specific best management practices, including development and implementation of a comprehensive SWMP to meet the MS4 permit standard and pollutant reduction requirements.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes, as amended, the Federal Clean Water Act, as amended, and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to issue Statewide General Permit NVS040000 to discharge. The Division has made the tentative determination to issue the permit for a five (5) year period.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, should submit their comments or request, in writing, hand delivered or postmarked no later than **5:00 P.M. on Thursday, June 25, 2026**, either in person or by mail to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day period will be considered in the formulation of final determination(s) regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant

degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
