PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 445B, the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 445B, and the Clean Air Act, the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection is issuing the following Notice of Proposed Action.

The Director received an application for a renewal of Class II Air Quality Operating Permit, AP1442-3436.01 (FIN A1735) from the following applicant:

3D Concrete LLC

Sparks, Nevada 89431

3D Concrete LLC – Dayton Pit is located at 75 Old Como Road, Dayton, Nevada 89403. The project is located in all or portions of Section 24, Township 16N, Range 21E, M.D.B.&M.

The permit action includes renewal of the existing Class II Air Quality Operating Permit No. AP1442-3436.01. The facility is a construction sand and gravel facility consisting of Systems 10 through 15 (PF1.023 through PF1.036), Systems 18 through 23 (S2.003 through S2.008), and an insignificant activity IA1.001.

On the basis of the preliminary review and the requirements of the NRS, the NAC and the Clean Air Act, the Director is hereby announcing his intent to issue the proposed Class II Air Quality Operating Permit based on a review of the information submitted.
