Director’s Review and Preliminary Determination of Permit Issuance for

**Wilkin Mining & Trucking, Inc.
Wilkin Facility
Lincoln County, Nevada
May 5, 2026**

Wilkin Mining & Trucking, Inc. (Wilkin Mining) submitted an application for an administrative renewal Class II Air Quality Operating Permit, AP1499-3721, FIN A1948, for the Wilkin facility in Lincoln County, Nevada. The project is located approximately 1 mile north of Panaca, Nevada, in all or portions of Section 05, Township 02 S, Range 68 E, M.D.B.&M.

Wilkin Mining is proposing an administrative renewal of the existing Class II Air Quality Operating Permit.

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection – Bureau of Air Pollution Control (BAPC) has reviewed the application for the above-referenced operating permit and has made a preliminary determination to issue the operating permit. The facility-wide Potential to Emit (PTE), including emissions from Non-Permit equipment are given in the table below.

The project is located in Air Quality Hydrographic Area (HA) 203 of the Panaca Valley. HA 203 is not a triggered basin for an increment analysis. Wilkin Mining will be subject to 40 CFR Part 60 Subpart OOO and 40 CFR Part 60 Subpart UUU.

Air dispersion modeling conducted by the applicant and the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection – Bureau of Air Quality Planning (BAQP) demonstrates that continued operation of Wilkin Mining, will not violate any air quality standard.

Wilkin Mining must comply with all State and Federal air quality requirements and all conditions established within the proposed draft Class II Air Quality Operating Permit.
