PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 445B, the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 445B, and the Clean Air Act, the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection is issuing the following Notice of Proposed Action.

The Director received an application for a renewal of Class II Air Quality Operating Permit AP1611-3457.02 (FIN A0487) from the following applicant:

H.E. Hunewill Construction Company, Inc.

Winnemucca, NV 89445

H.E. Hunewill Construction Company, Inc. – Thomas Creek-Sonoma Pit is located 5.5 miles south of Winnemucca on Grass Valley Road. The project is located in all or portions of Section 24, Township 35N, Range 37E, M.D.B.&M and Section 19, Township 35N, Range 38E, M.D.B.&M.

The facility shall continue to operate a portable aggregate screening plant, aggregate crushing and screening plants, an aggregate washing plant, a hot mix asphalt plant, and a marination plant.

On the basis of the preliminary review and the requirements of the NRS, the NAC and the Clean Air Act, the Director is hereby announcing his intent to issue the proposed Class II Air Quality Operating Permit based on a review of the information submitted.
