PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 445B, the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 445B, and the Clean Air Act, the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection is issuing the following Notice of Proposed Action.

The Director received an application for a new Class I Air Quality Operating Permit to Construct (OPTC), AP3692-4630 (FIN A1768A) from the following applicant:

Tesla, Inc.
1 Electric Avenue
Sparks, NV 89434

Tesla, Inc is located at 1 Electric Avenue, Sparks, NV 89434, in all or portions of Sections 5 – 8, Township 19N, Range 23E, M.D.B.&M.

Tesla is building a high-volume heavy-duty truck manufacturing facility. Semi-truck manufacturing activities will include a series of processes to assemble cab and battery enclosure components, preparing drive unit (rotor and drive axle) components, and battery module assembly followed by general assembly of the final semi-truck.

On the basis of the preliminary review and the requirements of the NRS, the NAC and the Clean Air Act, the Director is hereby announcing his intent to issue the proposed Class I Air Quality Operating Permit to Construct based on a review of the information submitted.
