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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

McGinley and Associates, Inc. (MGA) conducted this Phase I Environmental Site Assessment for the purpose of identifying recognized environmental conditions (RECs), historical recognized environmental conditions (HRECs), and/or controlled recognized environmental conditions (CRECs) on the property in accordance with the 2013 ASTM International standard practice for the performance of Phase I Environmental Site Assessments (ASTM E 1527-13). The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has endorsed this practice as satisfying the requirements of All Appropriate Inquiry (AAI).

The Subject Property is located in Henderson, Nevada and is comprised of a single parcel of land located within the S ¹/₂ of the SE ¹/₄ of Section 18, Township 22 South, Range 63 East, of the Mount Diablo Baseline and Meridian.

The Subject Property is approximately 1.61 acres in size and consists of undeveloped land covered with graded gravel. Evidence of past development on the site was observed in the form of a concrete driveway. Minor household and construction debris was observed on the site. The general slope of the surface appeared to be from the northeast to southeast.

<u>Findings</u>

General Findings

- The Subject Property is located on 1.61 acres and is identified as Clark County Assessor's Parcel 179-18-811-001.
- At the time of the site reconnaissance, the Subject Property was undeveloped. However, evidence suggests that the site was developed from the 1950s through the early 2000s with both residential dwellings and commercial structures.
- According to a local resident, city directories, and aerial photographs reviewed for this assessment, the Subject Property appears to have been previously developed with an address of 319 South Water Street.
- Previous uses of the Subject Property include residential dwellings, retail businesses that included Hairitage Salon and Four Seasons Cleaners. According to a local resident and the owner of the Four Seasons Cleaners in Clark County, the dry cleaning facility previously located on the Subject Property only operated as a drop-off and pick-up location.
- The properties surrounding the Subject Property primarily consist of commercial, retail, and residential properties.
- Two pole-mounted transformers were observed on the central portion of the Subject Property. The transformers appeared to be in good condition at the time of the site visit.

Historical Recognized Environmental Conditions (HREC)

No historical recognized environmental conditions were found for the Subject Property.

Controlled Recognized Environmental Conditions (CREC)

No controlled recognized environmental conditions were found for the Subject Property.

Recognized Environmental Conditions (REC)

No recognized environmental conditions were found for the Subject Property.

Conclusions

MGA has performed a Phase I Environmental Site Assessment in conformance with the scope and

limitations of ASTM Practice E 1527 of the property identified as APN 179-18-811-001 in the City of Henderson, Clark County, Nevada, the property. Any exceptions to, or deletions from, this practice are described in Section 7 of this report.

Upon conclusion of our Phase I ESA, and based on the information reviewed, this assessment has revealed no evidence of recognized environmental conditions or controlled recognized environmental conditions in connection with the Subject Property. Based on the information reviewed for this assessment, MGA is of the opinion that no additional investigations at the Subject Property are warranted at this time.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Purpose

This report presents the findings of a Phase I Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) performed on the property identified as APN 179-18-811-001 in the City of Henderson, Clark County, Nevada, and hereafter referred to as the Subject Property. McGinley and Associates, Inc. (MGA) conducted this investigation for the purpose of identifying recognized environmental conditions (RECs), historical recognized environmental conditions (HRECs), and/or controlled recognized environmental conditions (CRECs) on the property in accordance with the 2013 ASTM International standard practice for the performance of Phase I Environmental Site Assessments (ASTM E 1527-13). The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has endorsed this practice as satisfying the requirements of All Appropriate Inquiry (AAI).

1.2 Site Location

The Subject Property is located in Henderson, Nevada and is comprised of a single parcel of land located within the S ¹/₂ of the SE ¹/₄ of Section 18, Township 22 South, Range 63 East, of the Mount Diablo Baseline and Meridian. A parcel map from the Clark County Assessor's Office, which depicts the Subject Property parcel, is provided herein as Appendix A. The location of the site and the property boundary are displayed in Figures 1 and 2.

1.3 User Responsibilities

In order to qualify for one of the Landowner Liability Protections (LLPs) offered by the Small Business Liability Relief and Brownfields Revitalization Act of 2001 (the "Brownfields Amendments"), the User must complete an AAI compliant user questionnaire and provide it to the environmental professional. Failure to complete this user questionnaire could result in a determination that "all appropriate inquiry" is not complete. The questionnaire determines a baseline of User knowledge of the Subject Property regarding the following items:

- 1. Environmental cleanup liens that are filed or recorded against the site (40 CFR 312.25);
- 2. Activity and land use limitations that are in place on the site or have been filed or recorded in a registry (40 CFR 312.26);
- 3. Specialized knowledge or experience of the person seeking to qualify for the LLP related to the property or nearby properties (40 CFR 312.28);
- 4. Relationship of the purchase price to the fair market value of the property if it were not contaminated (40 CFR 312.29);
- 5. Commonly known or reasonably ascertainable information about the property (40 CFR 312.30); and;
- 6. The degree of obviousness of the presence or likely presence of contamination in, on, or at the property, and the ability to detect the contamination by appropriate investigation (40 CFR 312.31).

In order to obtain this information, an AAI compliant user questionnaire was provided to the User of this Phase I ESA. The completed user questionnaire can be found in Appendix B.

1.4 Conditions of Contract

MGA performed this work for the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) (client) on the behalf of the City of Henderson (user), as part of the State of Nevada Brownfields program pursuant to our proposal dated May 12, 2016, as part of the State of Nevada Brownfields program pursuant to our Scope of Work approval dated June 7, 2016. and in accordance with Contract DEP14-008, Task Number M05-14.

1.5 Scope of Work

The scope of work performed and procedures utilized included the following tasks:

- Site reconnaissance of the Subject Property and observation of adjoining properties and vicinity by a qualified person under the direct supervision of an MGA Certified Environmental Manager;
- Environmental setting review to determine potential pathways for the migration of contaminants including solids and liquids at the surface or subsurface, and vapor in the subsurface;
- **Review of site history/land use** through city directory listings, historical aerial photographs, historical topographic maps, local jurisdiction records, and personal interviews/questionnaires;
- **Review of regulatory agency records** to identify and assess any listings of regulatory permits, registrations, or enforcement actions at the subject site, adjoining properties, or proximal sites (if necessary), through both a commercial database search and agency inquiries; and,
- **Preparation of this report** that describes all work performed and presents a discussion of the findings and conclusions.

2. SITE RECONNAISSANCE

2.1 Methodology

For the purpose of assessing current site conditions, a visit to the Subject Property and surrounding area was conducted on June 15, 2016 under sunny and warm conditions. During the site visit, observations were made in regards to *recognized environmental conditions* (*RECs*). As defined by ASTM E 1527-13, a REC is the presence, or likely presence, of any hazardous substances or petroleum products in, on, or at the property due to any release to the environment, under conditions indicative of a release to the environment, or under conditions that pose a material threat of a future release to the environment. The term REC is not intended to include *de minimis* conditions that generally do not present a material risk of harm to public health or the environment and which generally would not be the subject of an enforcement action if brought to the attention of appropriate governmental agencies. Photographs taken during the site reconnaissance are provided in Appendix C.

2.2 Observations During Reconnaissance

The entire site was walked and observed for the presence of RECs. The following is a list of some of the items of interest that were looked for during the site inspection. If the item was not observed, it will be noted as "Not Observed". If the item was observed during the site visit, it will be noted as "**Observed**" and a short description of the finding will follow.

2.3 Site Description and Current Usage

The Subject Property is comprised of approximately 1.61 acres of land. At the time of the site visit, the Subject Property consisted of undeveloped land that appeared to have been graded in the past. Minor household trash and cinder blocks were observed on the northwest corner of the Subject Property. One small fill pile was also observed on the central portion during the site reconnaissance. Remnants from a driveway were observed on the northeast portion and two pole-mounted transformers were observed on the central portion of the Subject Property. Several concrete barrier blocks were observed along the center portion of the Subject Property from east to west. The general slope of the surface appeared to be from the

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northeast to southeast. At the time of the site reconnaissance, no potential environmental issues were observed.

2.4 Adjoining Properties

The Subject Property is bordered by the following:

North:	Commercial properties
South:	Retail and residential properties
East:	Nebraska Street with residential properties beyond
West:	South Water Street with undeveloped land beyond

At the time of the site visit, the properties immediately surrounding the Subject Property consisted primarily of commercial, residential and retail properties. Reconnaissance of the publicly accessible portions of the properties located immediately adjoining the Subject Property, revealed no visible evidence of environmental concerns that could potentially impact the Subject Property.

2.5 PCB Sources

Polychlorinated biphenyl (PCB) is a man-made chemical known to have potential harmful effects on human health and the environment. Federal law banned U.S. production of PCBs as of July 2, 1979. However, PCB-containing materials may still be present in electrical equipment manufactured prior to 1979. Given that the property was previously developed since the 1950's, a possibility exists that PCB-containing equipment were previously utilized at the site and transformers observed on the property at the time of the site visit may contain PCBs. The observed pole-mounted transformers appeared to be in good condition with no observed leaks. Furthermore, NV Energy has indicated that they no longer use PCB-containing oils in their transformers and make every effort to remove PCB-containing transformers and replace them with environmentally safer equipment.

3. ENVIRONMENTAL SETTING

3.1 Regional Physiographic Setting

The Subject Property is located within the Basin and Range Physiographic Province at an elevation of approximately 1,985 feet above mean sea level. The climate of the region is described as Mid-Latitude Steppe, which is characterized by cold winters, hot summers, and semi-arid precipitation conditions (Houghton et. al., 1975). Historical average minimum and maximum annual temperatures for the area, as recorded at the nearest climate station in Reno, Nevada, are 54.3 and 80.1 degrees Fahrenheit, respectively, while historical annual precipitation averages 4.15 inches (Western Regional Climate Center, 2015).

3.2 Geologic Conditions

The geology underlying the Subject Property has been mapped as Pediment and fan deposits of Henderson. The deposit is described as silty, sandy pebble gravel; composed dominantly of dacite clasts derived from the volcanic rocks of the McCullough Range (W. Bell and Smith, 1980). The surficial soils found at the Subject Property have been mapped as Caliza very gravelly sandy loam with slopes ranging from 2 to 8 percent. The unit is classified as Hydrologic Unit A, which is characterized by low run-off potential when thoroughly wet, as water freely transmits through the soil (NRCS, 2014).

3.3 Surface Water Conditions

There are no surface water bodies such as streams or wetlands located on the Subject Property. The nearest major surface water body to the Subject Property is the Las Vegas Wash, which is located approximately four miles north of the Subject Property.

According to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), the site is located outside a 100-year flood zone and is listed as being in Zone X, which is characterized as areas determined to be outside the 0.2% annual chance floodplain.

3.4 Groundwater Conditions

Based on a review of the Nevada Division of Water Resources (NDWR) Well Log Database, water wells may be located in the vicinity of the Subject Property, but their exact locations are unknown and their existence has not been field-verified. No wells were observed or reported to be located on the Subject Property during site reconnaissance. Groundwater flow direction at the Subject Property is estimated to be primarily towards the north. Groundwater depth is estimated to be approximately 50 to 75 feet below ground surface.

4. SITE HISTORY AND HISTORICAL LAND USE

A historical assessment of the Subject Property was performed through a search and review of historical aerial photographs, historical topographic maps, available Sanborn fire insurance maps, available city directory records, and county records. The purpose of the historical assessment was to identify potential conditions that may have impacted the Subject Property in the past. A summary of our historical assessment is presented below.

4.1 Historical Aerial Photographs

Environmental Data Resources, Inc. (EDR) provided aerial photographs covering the area of the Subject Property for the years: 1950, 1958, 1971, 1975, 1981, 1990, 1991, 1994, 1999, 2006, 2010, and the most current. Aerial photographs for years other than these were not reviewed. A review of the aerial photos indicates that the Subject Property was developed with residential properties in the past. The first occurrence of development on the Subject Property and in its vicinity is observed in the 1950 aerial photo. It appears the Subject Property and adjacent properties were residential in nature. Two ponds associated with a water treatment plant are visible to the south of the Subject Property. In 1958, expanded development is visible in the vicinity of the Subject Property. In the 1990 aerial photo, it appears that the residential homes no longer exist and several larger buildings appear on the Subject Property. In the 2010 aerial photo, several of the surrounding houses in the vicinity appear to be gone and commercial buildings appear. Only the northwest corner of the Subject Property appears to have development. The most current aerial photo shows the site as completely undeveloped and similar to what was observed at the time of the site visit.

The review of these aerial photographs did not reveal any potential environmental issues that may have impacted the Subject Property in the past. A copy of the historical aerial photograph report that was reviewed is provided in Appendix D.

4.2 Historical Topographic Maps

Historical topographic maps were provided by EDR covering the area of the Subject Property for the years: 1926, 1952, 1967, 1970, 1973, 1984, 2014, and 2015. Topographic maps for years other than these were not reviewed. A water treatment plant is visible to the south of the Subject Property in the reviewed topographic maps dated 1952 through 2014. The review of these maps did not reveal any potential environmental issues that may have impacted the Subject Property in the past. A copy of the historical topographic map report that was reviewed is provided in Appendix D.

4.3 Sanborn Fire Insurance Maps

A Sanborn Map Report for the Subject Property was provided by EDR. However, Sanborn fire insurance maps, which can often provide detailed historical information about a site, have not been published for the area of the Subject Property. A copy of the EDR Sanborn Map Report that was reviewed is provided in Appendix E.

4.4 City Directory Listings

At the request of MGA, EDR searched City Directory listings for West Cheyenne Avenue. City directory listings as published by Cole Information Services and Luskey Brothers & Co., and Polk's City Directory. Publications listings from the following years were provided for review: 1959, 1966, 1992, 1995, 1999, 2003, 2008, and 2013. According to further research, the Subject Property was listed as 319 South Water Street from 1992 to 2003. There were no

listings for the Subject Property or the adjacent properties prior to 1959. A summary of findings from the available city directory listings for the Subject Property and surrounding properties is provided in the table below. A copy of the EDR city directory report that was reviewed is provided in Appendix E.

4.5 Clark County Assessor's Office

According to the Clark County Assessor's Office, the Subject Property is listed as APN 179-18-811-001. The land use code of the Subject Property is listed as *Vacant*. The current property owner is listed as City of Henderson Redevelopment, which has owned the property since 2009. Ownership information prior to 2009 was not provided in the information available for review.

4.6 Interviews

4.6.1 Interview with Dave Season, Local Resident of Henderson, NV

A phone interview was conducted with Dave Beason, a local resident of Henderson NV, regarding his knowledge of the Subject Property. Mr. Beason stated that he was familiar with the history of the Subject Property. He stated that there was a long building on the Subject Property that was occupied by Hairitage and owned by a lady named Phyllis. At the south end of the building, there was Four Seasons Dry Cleaners. He stated that he used to frequent the dry cleaners and remembered it being a drop off and pick up only. He explained that there was no equipment typically used by dry cleaners and that he recalled only seeing clothing on the racks. Mr. Beason then stated that the roof had partially collapsed at one point. When asked if he was aware of any chemical spills, releases, or environmental issues that may have occurred on the Subject Property, he indicated that he was not aware of any incidents that have occurred at the property.

4.6.2 Interview with Raza Agha, Previous Owner of Four Season Cleaners

An interview was conducted with Raza Agha on July 7, 2016 regarding his knowledge on the Four Season Cleaners that was previously located on Water Street. He explained that he was the owner of all the Four Season Cleaners in Clark County. When asked if there was any cleaning equipment at the Four Seasons Cleaner on Water Street, Mr. Agha replied that all the cleaners have been drop-off only locations and that all the cleaning is conducted off property.

5. RECORDS REVIEW

As defined in ASTM E 1527-13, a *historical recognized environmental condition* is a past release of any hazardous substances or petroleum products that has been addressed to the satisfaction of the applicable regulatory authority (to current regulatory standards) or meets unrestricted residential use criteria established by a regulatory authority, without subjecting the property to institutional controls or engineering controls. A HREC will not be considered a REC per ASTM E 1527-13. To the contrary, a *controlled recognized environmental condition* is a REC that has been addressed to the satisfaction of the applicable regulatory authority with hazardous substances or petroleum products allowed to remain in place subject to the implementation of required controls (i.e., property use restrictions, activity use limitations, institutional/engineering controls, etc.).

A regulatory agency review was conducted through both a commercial database search and local agency inquiries. The purpose of this regulatory agency review was to ascertain if regulatory actions have ever been imposed on the Subject Property, adjoining properties, or on properties within the search radius guidelines established by the 2013 ASTM Standard Practice for Environmental Site Assessments.

5.1 EDR Radius Map Report

At the request of MGA, EDR provided records from federal, state, and local environmental databases for regulatory sites located within the *Approximate Minimum Search Distances* as specified in ASTM E 1527-13. A copy of the EDR report is included herein as Appendix F. Included within the report are summaries of the regulatory databases reviewed, a listing of sites identified within the search radius, detailed data on the identified sites, and maps showing the locations of facilities reported to have had regulatory action. MGA reviewed and evaluated all of the sites in the EDR report.

The Subject Property was not identified as a record in the databases searched by EDR. The following regulatory listings were identified within the Approximate Minimum Search Distances in the databases searched by EDR: one Superfund Enterprise Management System Archive (SEMS-ARCHIVE) site, one Corrective Action (CORRACTS) facility, 16 State Hazardous Waste Sites (SHWS), three US Underground Storage Tank (UST) sites, one Solid Waste Recycling (SWRCY) site, one Historic Auto site, and one Historic Cleaner site.

In order to evaluate potential impacts to the Subject Property, a review of pertinent regulatory agency files was conducted on one of the above listed sites, which is located on the Subject Property. Additional information obtained for this site is provided in Section 5.3 of this report.

The remaining sites identified in the EDR Radius Map Report were not researched further because they are considered unlikely to have caused environmental impacts to the Subject Property in the past, because they appear to be located far from the Subject Property, are at locations that are considered likely to be hydrologically downgradient from, or cross-gradient to, the Subject Property, have had no reported releases, have had no reported violations of hazardous waste regulations, and/or have received regulatory closure.

The EDR database search also identified a number of sites that could not be mapped due to insufficient address information. MGA reviewed all of these sites and has determined that each are located far from the Subject Property, are at locations that are considered likely to be hydrologically downgradient from, or cross-gradient to, the Subject Property, have had no reported releases, have had no reported violations of hazardous waste regulations, and/or

have received regulatory closure. For this reason, the unmapped sites are considered unlikely to cause, or to have caused in the past, environmental impact to the Subject Property.

5.2 EDR Vapor Encroachment Screen

MGA conducted a Vapor Encroachment Screen (VES) investigation in accordance with the 2015 ASTM Standard Guide for Vapor Encroachment Screening on Property Involved in Real Estate Transactions (ASTM E 2600-15). The VES investigation used available information and professional judgment to derive our conclusions. The goal of the VES is to identify the potential for vapors from hazardous substances and petroleum releases to reach the Subject Property. ASTM E2600-15 defines the term, vapor encroachment condition (VEC) as the presence or likely presence of chemical of concern (COC) vapors in the vadose zone of the Subject Property caused by the release of vapors from contaminated soil and/or groundwater either on or near the Subject Property as identified by Tier 1 or Tier 2 procedures. MGA performed a VES for the area encompassing the Subject Property by reviewing each of the regulatory sites that were provided by EDR within a 1/3-mile primary search radius from the boundary of the Subject Property.

5.2.1 Tier 1 Screening

Initially, three sites were identified within the 1/3-mile primary search radius surrounding the Subject Property. MGA reviewed each of the sites to evaluate their potential to create a vapor encroachment condition. Of the initial three sites, two sites had limited potential for the presence of contaminants of concern; were determined to be outside the area of concern based on distance, gradient, and the type of COC; and/or were determined to be beyond the critical distance for vapor migration to the Subject Property. For the remaining site, a Tier 2 Screening was performed.

5.2.2 Tier 2 Screening

A historic dry cleaner previously addressed at 319 S. Water Street was identified on the Subject Property. No leaks or spills are known to have occurred at this facility in the past. In addition, according to an interview conducted with Dave Beason, a former resident local to the Subject Property, the dry cleaner facility was a drop off and pick up location only. Therefore, a VEC can be ruled out. A copy of the VES report is included herein as Appendix G.

5.3 Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP)

The regulatory agency review did not identify any regulatory sites administered by the NDEP that could potentially impact the Subject Property. Therefore, no agency files from the NDEP were requested for review.

5.4 Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD)

On June 7, 2016, an inquiry regarding inspections, complaints, spills or other potential environmental issues in connection with the Subject Property and/or its adjoining properties was submitted via electronic mail to the Southern Nevada Health Department. On June 8, 2016, MGA received a response from the SNHD stating that files related to the property addressed 319 South Water Street and the adjacent properties could not be located.

6. FINDINGS

6.1 General Findings

- The Subject Property is located on 1.61 acres and is identified as Clark County Assessor's Parcel 179-18-811-001.
- At the time of the site reconnaissance, the Subject Property was undeveloped. However, evidence suggests that the site was developed from the 1950s through the early 2000s with both residential dwellings and commercial structures.
- According to a local resident, city directories, and aerial photographs reviewed for this assessment, the Subject Property appears to have been previously developed with an address of 319 South Water Street.
- Previous uses of the Subject Property include residential dwellings, retail businesses that included Hairitage Salon and Four Seasons Cleaners. According to a local resident and the owner of the Four Seasons Cleaners in Clark County, the dry cleaning facility previously located on the Subject Property only operated as a drop-off and pick-up location.
- The properties surrounding the Subject Property primarily consist of commercial, retail, and residential properties.
- Two pole-mounted transformers were observed on the central portion of the Subject Property. The transformers appeared to be in good condition at the time of the site visit.

6.2 Historical Recognized Environmental Conditions

No historical recognized environmental conditions were found for the Subject Property.

6.3 Controlled Recognized Environmental Conditions

No controlled recognized environmental conditions were found for the Subject Property.

6.4 Recognized Environmental Conditions

No recognized environmental conditions were found for the Subject Property.

6.5 Conclusions

MGA has performed a Phase I Environmental Site Assessment in conformance with the scope and limitations of ASTM Practice E 1527 of the property identified as APN 179-18-811-001 in the City of Henderson, Clark County, Nevada, the property. Any exceptions to, or deletions from, this practice are described in Section 7 of this report.

Upon conclusion of our Phase I ESA, and based on the information reviewed, this assessment has revealed no evidence of recognized environmental conditions or controlled recognized environmental conditions in connection with the Subject Property. Based on the information reviewed for this assessment, MGA is of the opinion that no additional investigations at the Subject Property are warranted at this time.

7.1 General

The conclusions and recommendations presented above are based upon the agreed scope of work outlined in the above report. - Past owners were not available within reasonable time and/or cost constraints for interview for this report. However, based on information obtained from EDR and Clark County records, this data gap is not considered significant since it is likely all information obtained would be duplicative of information obtained from other sources.




