**RECOMMENDATION:**

Adoption of Site-Specific Board Determination No. C2026-02 as proposed, granting additional cleanup funding in accordance with Board Policy Resolution 2023-01 under the State of Nevada Petroleum Fund to Gas 2 Go for \$900,000. This represents \$1,000,000 in coverage minus a 10% copayment.
