RCRA Hazardous Waste Permitting Fees¹

• **Certificate of Designation, RCRA Permit** or **Written Determination** – the fee amount is dependent upon the specific type of regulated unit and/or hazardous waste operation. A deposit in the amount indicated below is due at the time of application submittal. Staff time devoted to processing of the application will then be charged against the deposit at a rate of \$50/hour.

Landfill, Boiler, Industrial Furnace or Incinerator ²	\$50,000
Treatment Unit	50,000
Surface Impoundment, Thermal Treatment, Waste Pile	
Storage Unit	25,000
Written Determination for Facility for the Recycling of Hazardous Waste w/o Stor	
Written Determination for Mobile Unit for the Recycling of Hazardous Waste	10,000

• **Permit Modification** – fee amount depends upon the type of modification

Modification Type ³	<u>Fee</u>
Class 1 (with prior approval)	\$500
Class 2	1,500
Class 3	5,000

• RCRA Permit Renewal – fee due with renewal application every 5 years

All Permit Types \$15,000

• Annual Permit Fee – due March 1st, depends on the type of regulated unit

Permitted Activity or Regulated Unit	Annual Permit Fee
Landfill, Boiler, Industrial Furnace or Incinerator	\$50,000
Treatment Unit	10,000
Thermal Treatment of Waste Munitions of the Armed Forces of the United Sta	tes or
its contractor, including, without limitation, detonation	7,500
Storage of hazardous waste	2,500

• Quarterly Volume Fee – due 30 days after each quarter ends, amount depends upon type of hazardous waste received and type of treatment and/or disposal in prior quarter.

Permitted Activity or Regulated Unit	Quarterly Permit Fee	
Disposal via landfill, boiler, industrial furnace, incinerator, open burning or open detonation of:		
RCRA hazardous waste	\$19.00 / ton	
Treated waste that is no longer hazardous at time of disposal	4.00 / ton	
 PCB waste or waste designated as hazardous in its State of origin 	3.50 / ton	
(but is not RCRA hazardous waste)		
Treatment/Storage of waste for offsite disposal	5.00 / ton	

^{1.} This fee structure was approved by the State Environmental Commission on 8 Oct, 2014, with an effective date of 24 Oct, 2014. Until codified, the adopted regulation can be found in the <u>LCB File No. R038-13A</u>, dated 24 Oct, 2014.

^{2.} If the facility contains both a landfill and an hazardous waste incinerator, then the maximum fee is \$100,000.

Class 1, Class 2 and Class 3 modifications have the meanings ascribed to them in Appendix I of 40 C.F.R. 270.42, as adopted by reference in NAC 444.8632.
