Summary:

- 1) Michael Antoine (Michael) started the Public Workshop (Workshop) by reviewing the agenda, which included the following topics: list of Bureau of Safe Drinking Water (BSDW) Laboratory Certification Program (LCP) staff, ways for the public to participate and comment on the regulation revisions, review how regulations are created/revised, role of the State Environmental Commission (SEC), the need for an LCP fee increase, NAC 445A.066 changes, NAC 445A.54296 changes, NAC 459.96986 changes, a summary of proposed revisions, general cleanup revisions, public comments and questions, and end of Workshop.
- 2) Michael presented the need for an LCP fee increase, owing to the reality that the last LCP fee increase was in 2004, with a subsequent cumulative price increase of 61%. Michael then delineated the fee increases proposed in R130-22, which included a 40% increase in the annual application fee for certification year 2023, a 40 % increase in the annual method/analyte certification fees for certification year 2024, new fees for Cyanobacteria analyses, new fees for the Nevada Mining Laboratory Approval Program, a 15% over previous year fee increases for 2025, a 10% increase over previous year increase for years 2026-2077, a 5% increase in 2028, and an optional 3% increase to annual fees each year thereafter, at the discretion of the DCNR Director.
- 3) Michael then presented proposed additions and deletions section by section for NAC 445A.066 (Clean Water Act and Mining analyses fees), NAC 445A.54296 (Safe Drinking Water analyses fees), 459.96986 (Resource Conservation and Recovery Act analyses fees), and concluded with a summary of the proposed revisions and a section-by-section summary of the general clean-up of NAC 445A.
- 4) There were no members of the public present in person and one question asked by an on-line attendee, Bill Reaves Eurofins Environmental Testing, inquiring as to the availability of the presentation slides. Mr. Reaves was informed that the slides would be posted to the NDEP web page within an hour of the conclusion of the workshop or via email from any Lab Cert personnel. Jasmine Curiel asked for additional questions (there were none) and Andrea Siefert reminded participants to email questions or comments in support or opposition to the proposed regulation before the December 5, 2023, SEC hearing.
