Re: Annual Recycling Data Collection

Dear Recycler:

In order to generate a report that accurately reflects the state of recycling in Nevada, the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) collects recycling data annually. All Nevada Counties are encouraged to participate in this survey and counties with populations greater than 45,000 are strongly encouraged/required to provide certain recycling services. County data is compiled by NDEP to calculate the state recycling rate, and will be available on <https://ndep.nv.gov/nevada-recycles/resources/reports> when finalized.

We would greatly appreciate your cooperation with county employees working to gather recycling data in a timely manner. According to NAC 444A.135, the deadline for Form B to be returned to your county is **February 15, 2020**. Pages 2 and 3 of Form B standardizes data collection and lists the materials typically counted as recyclable in Nevada. Only materials generated within the county to which you are reporting should be counted. Should you collect or process materials from multiple counties, please do your best to report to each county separately. It is also important to indicate which processor or collector your recyclable materials go to in order to minimize double-counting those same materials. Form B should be provided to you by the county, and can also be found online at <https://ndep.nv.gov/nevada-recycles/resources/reports>.
