Notes regarding the recycling data:

- This Recycling Rate Report provides recycling data for all counties in Nevada. However, only six (6) counties are required to report to NDEP: Carson City, Clark, Douglas, Elko, Lyon, and Washoe. Therefore, other counties may under report recycling tonnages.
- The percentages listed for recycled material types represent the proportion of the total recycled material stream attributed to each material (e.g., Glass accounts for 2.64% of the stream. It does **not** indicate that glass has a recycling rate of 2.64%.)
