2. An application must be accompanied by:
 - a. An application fee of \$800

A plan for action and proper notification of authorities in the event of a hurricane, typhoon, tornado, storm, flood, high water, wind-driven water, earthquake, volcanic eruption, landslide, mudslide, snowstorm, drought, fire, explosion, electrical outage, attack, sabotage or toxic spill or other spill that could pose a health hazard. - (1) The daily operations of the water system, including the cost of monitoring the system;**

(2) Any anticipated capital improvements

c. An estimate of the itemized costs of the construction of any water facilities. **Attach as a separate document.**
