Requesting and considering information a sub-divider has failed to submit – each request	\$100	

For reviewing water project plans associated with final maps of subdivisions, the fees specified in NAC 445A.6664 shall be charged. For reviewing applications to operate a new water system, the fee specified in NAC 445A.604 shall be charged.

WATER SYSTEM PROJECTS

Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2 of NAC 445A.6669, for reviewing an application for a permit to construct, modify or expand a public water system.

For reviewing on-site and off-site improvement plans for a subdivision for a new system or for the expansion of an existing system.	\$250	plus \$3 for each connection for supply of water to customers
Reviewing plans not specifically related to subdivisions to modify or make system improvements to the public water system	\$300	
Reviewing a treatment facility (initial construction or modification to existing facility) <i>For the purposes of this section, "capital" cost is the engineer-certified cost estimate of the facility.</i>	0.1% of the capital cost of facility, but not to exceed \$3,250

Issuance Of An Annual Permit To Operate A Treatment Plant

(when chlorination is not considered treatment)

Less than 500,000 gallons per day	\$150
500,000 gallons per day to less than 1 million gallons per day (MGD)	\$250
1 MGD to less than 5 MGD	\$1,500
5 MGD to less than 10 MGD	\$2,000
10 MGD to less than 50 MGD	\$3,000
50 MGD to less than 100 MGD	\$4,000
100 MGD and greater	\$7,500
