# Requirement for Ranking


A priority system must be used to rank projects that are considered eligible for financial assistance from the fund

- 33 U.S. Code §1383(g)
- NAC 445A.767(1)

The priority system must give highest priority to projects that are necessary to meet the enforceable requirements of the Clean Water Act.


Include in the criteria for ranking projects:

- The elimination of pollution from waters within the state
- The protection of health of the public
- The attainment of standards of water quality adopted by the state
- The operation of the fund in such a manner so as to impose the least possible financial burden on municipalities.


## Priority Class A

Projects that  
benefit  
public health  
and/or  
environment

Treatment works or pollution control projects:

- Necessary to eliminate documented public health hazards
- To correct existing violations of surface water quality standards
- To correct existing violations of discharge permit limitations
- To eliminate and/or prevent interference with an existing beneficial use of groundwater.

**Documentation to support the project need is required.**



## Priority Class B


Projects to  
Increase  
reliability  
and  
sustainability

Treatment works or pollution control projects:

- To provide a degree of treatment beyond water quality standards or permit requirements
- To reclaim and reuse wastewater
- To sustain compliance with water quality standards
- To maintain beneficial uses
- To address facility flow or loading
- To address sewer system rehabilitation and reclaimed water distribution

**Documentation to support the project need is required.**





## Priority Class C

Projects  
meeting  
other clean  
water needs

Treatment works or pollution control projects:

- To existing unsewered communities with no public health hazards or water quality standards violations
- To provide wastewater collection to unsewered portions of sewerred communities
- All other treatment works or pollution control projects

# Water Quality Factor (WQF)

NDEP is required to develop Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs) for those water bodies that do not meet water quality standards.

NDEP then establishes the allowable loadings of pollutants or other quantifiable parameters for a waterbody, based on the relationship between point and non-point pollution sources and in-stream water quality conditions.

TMDLs are prioritized by designated use classifications and the severity of pollution. The numerical value of WQF is based on where a treatment plant discharges or what is affected by the discharge from a non-point source.

- (5 points) Not supporting: at least one of the water quality standards for the beneficial use was not met
- (5 points) Groundwater impairment that affects water quality
- (1 point) Fully supporting: however, a project is needed to maintain water quality standards

# Asset Management

- *Applies to ALL Classes*
  - *(1 pt) System is mapped & assets are cataloged/evaluated*
  - *(1 pt) System has a rate structure that supports O&M*
  - *(1 pt) System has allocated funds for rehabilitation/replacement of aging infrastructure*

# Project Readiness

- Applies to ALL Classes
  - (10 pts) Project Plans and Specifications approved by NDEP – Ready to Bid
  - (7 pts) Facility plan approved by NDEP & final plans/specification to be completed in 6 months
  - (5 pts) Facility plan approved by NDEP

# Green Projects

(5 pts):

- Water & energy efficiency upgrades;
- On-site clean power production;
- Reuse of effluent;
- Establishment or restoration of permanent riparian buffers, other vegetative buffers, floodplains, or wetlands;
- Project to manage wet weather & restore hydrology by infiltration, evapotranspiration, or harvesting & use of storm water; or
- Green storm water infrastructure

# Affordability for additional subsidy

## **Nevada Administrative Code:**

No definition. Program requirements must be outlined in the annual Intended Use Plan (NAC 445A.764)

## **Federal Clean Water Act Requirements:**

Section 603(i)(2) requires states to develop affordability criteria for additional subsidization based on income, unemployment data, population trends, and other data determined relevant by the state.

## **2023 Clean Water Intended Use Plan:**

- 50 points are needed to qualify for principal forgiveness
- 25 points will be added to the initial score for systems qualifying through the affordability criteria

# Affordability criteria

- Income Factors
  - Median Household Income versus State MHI
  - Poverty Levels in the service area
- Population trends
  - Change in population over a three-year period based upon the latest American Community Survey data available
- Unemployment
  - Percent of the population not in the workforce
  - Unemployment rate of service area
- Affordability
  - Whether or not an interest-bearing loan will increase already sufficient user rates by 10%, 20%, or 30%.
    - This also has a look-back option for 5 years.
  - Residential rates compared to MHI
    - Based on 1.0%, 1.5%, and 2.0%
- Other Factors
  - Nature of the project
  - Incentives for project types
  - Financial assistance from government or political subdivisions

# Disadvantaged systems

## **Nevada Administrative Code amended<sup>1</sup>:**

“Disadvantaged community” means an area in which, as compared to other communities in this State, residents disproportionately experience economic, environmental or health issues, including, without limitation, high rates of poverty or unemployment.

(NAC 445A.675245)

## **Federal Clean Water Act Requirements:**

[42 U.S.C §300j-12(b)(d)(3)] the term “disadvantaged community” means the service area of a public water system that meets affordability criteria established after public review and comment by the State in which the public water system is located.

## **2023 Drinking Water Intended Use Plan:**

- 50 points are needed to qualify for principal forgiveness
- 25 points will be added to the initial score for systems qualifying as disadvantaged
